## Information We Share

There are certain circumstances in which we transfer your personal data to employees, contractors and to other parties.

- We share information about you with our charity, The Hibernian Community Foundation. They are bound to keep and use your information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
- We also share your information with other organisations who we have appointed to carry out data processing activities on our behalf. These include our ticket services provider, our marketing database provider, our online and club store provider and the provider of Hibs TV. Other service providers include mailing houses, delivery organisations, credit risk management companies, payment processing organisations, advertising agencies, IT suppliers, database providers, backup and disaster recovery specialists, and email providers.

Our suppliers and service providers are required to meet our standards on processing information and security. The information we provide them, including your information, will only be provided in connection with the performance of their function. They will not be permitted to use your information for any purposes other than those outlined in this Privacy Policy.

- We also share your information with certain third parties. We will do this either when we receive your consent or because we need them to see your information to provide products or services to you. These include credit reference agencies, anti-fraud databases, screening agencies and other partners we do business with.

Your personal information may be transferred to other third party organisations in certain scenarios:

- If we discuss selling or transferring part or all of our business – the information may be transferred to prospective purchasers under suitable terms as to confidentiality;
- If we are reorganised or sold, information may be transferred to a buyer who can continue to provide services to you;
- If we're required to by law, or under any regulatory code or practice we follow, or if we are asked by any public or regulatory authority – for example the Police;
- If we are defending a legal claim your information may be transferred as required in connection with defending such claim; and/or
- If it is necessary to do so to enforce our terms of use or other contractual rights.

Your personal data may be shared if it is made anonymous and aggregated, as in such circumstances the information will cease to be personal data.
